PAGE 1:

PANEL 1:

TEXT PANEL:

Recap: The War between the peaceful AUTOBOTS and the aggressive warmongering DECEPTICONS had lasted for millions of years.

It had swept to EARTH where the Autobots had allied with the human race and finally to the Planet Nebulon, where the Autobots and Decepticons had bonded themselves physically and mentally to two opposing Factions of the green skinned humanoid natives – the tyrannical psychic powered HIVE who were controlling the planet and the REBELS who were fighting them... becoming HEADMASTERS and TARGETMASTERS.

The Supreme Leader of the Hive LORD ZARAK had transformed their entire city into the city-sized Super Headmaster SKORPONOK.

To counter this, the Autobots oldest human ally SPIKE WITWICKY had bonded with the Autobot CEREBROS and became the Autobot City Headmaster FORTRESS MAXIMUS.

In one last Great Battle over the fate of CYBERTRON and EARTH and the opening of the ancient device known as the Plasma Energy Chamber by the Decepticons had nearly caused a SUPERNOVA that would have destroyed both planets.

But Spike, along with their nebulon allies, had managed to reverse the effect of the Chamber, preventing the nova and restoring with nearly unlimited energy Cybertron to a New Golden Age.

All that however had been part of a plan by the sentient super-computer VECTOR SIGMA, who had been manipulating both sides as part of his design to restore the energy reserves of Cybertron.

It was a plan that had **intentionally** brought two planets at the brink of destruction. But it had brought the homeworld of the Transformers a new Golden Age and ended the War.

... or so it seemed.

PANEL 2:

CAPTION: The last battle had been costly.

WIDE SHOT, HIGH ANGLE – Showing several deactivated Autobots lying on the surface of Cybertron... the Aerialbot Leader Silverbolt in the middle.

Captioned: Several Autobots lost their lives.

PANEL 3:

Scene of Skorponok and Fortress Maximus clashing with each other on Cybertron.

PANEL 4:

View on Fortress Maximus flying in space-ship mode towards the planet Nebulon.

Captioned: The celebration about their victory had ended a couple days ago. The Autobot Leader OPTIMUS PRIME and the Autobot Head- and Targetmasters, have travelled to Nebulon to remove

the remains of Zarak and the Hive's reign and reprogramm the machines they had used to oppress the people of Nebulon to help them instead.

PAGE 2:

PANEL 1:

CAPTION: The Planet NEBULON, the Year 2007 - a few days after the events of 'The Rebirth'.

INT. Fortress Maximus, City-mode

CLOSE SHOT – On Optimus sitting in a transformer-sized chair alone in one of the rooms inside Fortress Maximus.

Captioned: Things had become a bit quieter, especially for OPTIMUS PRIME. And with the first euphoria gone, another emotion was beginning to take place... doubt.

PANEL 2:

WIDE SHOT – Hotrod enters the room and sees Optimus.

Captioned: HOTROD - who had for two years been the Autobot leader RODIMUS PRIME - finds him like this.

OPTIMUS

Hotrod. Rodimus. (He says his other name.) Tell me, do you think we did the right thing?

HOTROD

The right thing?

OPTIMUS

I refused to destroy the key. I practically intentionally let Galvatron open the Plasma Energy Chamber.

PANEL 3:

OPTIMUS

(CONT.)

I risked the destruction of an entire star system, the lives of billions of living beings, the humans, the Autobots, even the inhabitants of the moon Titan, all for a promise of Vector Sigma.

HOTROD

It worked out. But...

PANEL 4:

OPTIMUS

Yes, but if even the slightest thing had gone wrong, everything could have been destroyed.

And it would have been my fault.

HOTROD

Hey - we all trust you with our lives. I admit we all had our doubts, but we trust your judgement. And in the end you were right.

OPTIMUS

Did I? Or was it just coincidence that we survived? Just dumb luck? It seemed all so clear back then but now?

PANEL 5:

WIDE SHOT – At SPIKE, his son DANIEL, both of them in their Headmaster exo-suits, ARCEE, KUP and the now former Nebulon Rebel Leader GORT have just entered the room behind them.

SPIKE

Hey - so this is where you are. We have been looking for you.

OPTIMUS

It is alright Spike. We have just been... talking about something.

PAGE 3:

PANEL 1:

KUP

There is also something I wanted to talk about with you about Optimus. We have just gotten message from Cybertron.

It is like I feared, all traces in what direction Skorponok and Galvatron were sent to are gone.

PANEL 2

GORT

Is this really such a problem? They are gone. Nebulon, Cybertron and Earth are save.

OPTIMUS

Yes WE are save. Others are not. They are out there somewhere between a trillion stars, with thousands of planets as possible targets.

Captioned: Optimus thinking: '...and all that because of Vector Sigma's plan.'

PANEL 3:

CAPTION: The Decepticon City/Flagship SKORPONOK. 'Deep Space' Millions of light-years away - in the area the humans call the Triangulum Galaxy

EXT. Skorponok, in his space-ship mode was still flying through an unknown region of space.

PANEL 4:

INT. A corridor inside Skorponok

TWO SHOT - Two SWEEPS are standing guard in front of a room.

PANEL 5:

WIDE SHOT - GALVTRON, CYCLONUS, SCOURGE, LORD ZARAK and the Headmaster MINDWIPE, along with his nebulon partner the scientist VORATH, are sitting inside the room together.

With all of them sitting in their respective, transformer - or in Zarak's case nebulon-sized chairs.

Captioned: They are having a very special conversation.

CYCLONUS

This should be about everything.

ZARAK

You are telling us that you yourself don't know why you opened the Plasma Energy Chamber?" he asked in disbelief.

I heard that you used to have... well – mental problems.

NOTE: Zarak is in his Headmaster exo-suit, but without his helmet and his face visible.

PAGE 4:

PANEL 1:

GALVATRON

Don't try my patience Zarak. That is in the past. I had Cybertron back under Decepticon control. Why should I try to destroy it?

CYCLONUS

Zarak - we can not even remember clearly HOW we found out about the Plasma Energy Chamber in the first place. And we never questioned this until NOW.

Captioned: This causes Zarak to frown. He had to admit they were right.

PANEL 2:

ZARAK

Okay - I admit there is something strange going on here.

GALVATRON

Did you find anything - Mindwipe, Vorath?

PANEL 3:

TWO SHOT: Mindwipe with his smaller Nebulon partner standing next to him.

MINDWIPE

Yes, you have definitely been manipulated by an outside force. There is something dark upon the three of you, very dark.

VORATH

Now that was **really** helpful (sarcasm). But I agree. it seems you had been under some kind of mental influence.

Captioned: Galvatron truly wished Soundwave were here. He would have trusted him far more with this than this two. But Soundwave had been in charge of Trypticon had been left behind in their home-sector.

Well, Galvatron is sure Soundwave can take care of himself.

PANEL 4:

WIDE SHOT: Galvatron is sitting in his chair, with Cyclonus and Scourge (having stood up) standing next to him.

SCOURGE

It - it was the Matrix. I remember now. After Optimus Prime opened it in front of us the knowledge just appeared in my head.

PANEL 5:

GALVATRON

Yes... yes - you are right. I remember it too now.

MINDWIPE

But why would the Matrix want you to destroy Cybertron and Earth?

Captioned: That was a good question.

PAGE 5:

PANEL 1:

SCOURGE

Maybe there are parts of it's plans that we do not know about. Maybe it set something in motion to save Cybertron before...

GALVATRON

Going by the idea that there **is** a sentient entity behind the Matrix and it is not just a power source or weapon, right Scourge?

There was a sharp undertone in Galvatron's voice as he said this.

PANEL 2:

SCOURGE

Ah – yes. (nervously)

PANEL 3:

CYCLONUS

(thinking)

This is a dangerous topic between them, given Scourge's failed rebellion with the MATRIX a few months ago'

Scourge had claimed that he had been influenced and somehow possessed by it.

CAPTIONED: This was something that Cyclonus had come more or less to accept. If **Galvatron** accepted it was another matter. Nobody was absolutely sure how much of Scourge's actions at that time were completely his own... probably not even Scourge himself.'

PANEL 4:

WIDE SHOT – at Galvatron with Cyclonus to his right and Scourge to his left.

CYCLONUS

I don't think there should be much doubt about the Matrix being sentient at this point.

Anyway, I think we should go by the idea that Cybertron, Earth... and the Autobots, might still exist.

Captioned: Galvatron looks thoughtful for a moment.

PANEL 5:

GALVATRON

Even if it does, it does not change anything about our plans now.
Zarak - have you located a promising planet?

ZARAK

Yes - it is a planet quite similar to Nebulon. Potentially rich sources of energy. We are receiving radio-signals.

GALVATRON

Get enough to analyse the natives language. It would be a hazzle to conquer people we can not even understand.

PANEL 6:

WIDE SHOT: Cyclonus and Scourge leaving the room through the opened door. (With Zarak, Mindwipe and Vorath having already left before them.)

With Galvatron behind them still sitting in his chair.

SCOURGE

Galvatron's state has improved much. It seems your efforts to help him have finally paid of.

CYCLONUS

Yes. First after Torkulon and then again after... the Hate Plaque."

Captioned: Galvatron meanwhile stays behind by himself in his room. And all what was left was doubt - Why exactly had he tried to destroy his home-planet in a supernova if he didn't have to?

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PANEL 1:

CAPTION: The Decepticons are assembled inside Skorponok's large space-ship form's different hangars and corridors.

WIDE SHOT – The Targetmasters SLUGSLINGER, TRIGGERHAPPY and MISFIRE, SIXSHOT, RAMJET, DIRGE and THRUST...

... the Actionmasters KROK and TREADSHOT, the Duocons FLYWHEELS and BATTLETRAP and two dark blue and a military green colored F15 SEEKERS of the same design as Starscream, Skywarp and Thundercracker and others are standing together in a large hall...

Captioned: Their numbers include the Target- and Headmasters, the Sweeps, Sixshot, the Constructi-, Combati-, Stunti-, Preda- and Terrorcons, Astrotrain, Ramjet, Dirge and Thrust, the Duocons Flywheels and Battletrap, Runabout and Runamuck, Wingspan and Pounce, the Actionmasters, The Triggercons... and many more.

All in all nearly 200 Decepticons. Not much on the galactic scale. But they are the core of the Decepticon Army. Galvatron's voice comes over the loudspeakers:

GALVATRON

(off panel)

Decepticons - Attack. Destroy everything that stands in your way.

PANEL 2:

CAPTION: Skorponok had entered the atmosphere of the planet.

WIDE SHOT - The Decepticons fly in front of Skorponok's space ship form.

A large number of them have transformed into their jet- or other flight capable alt-modes, while some staid in robot-mode.

With Cyclonus in his spacejet-mode taking the lead of the jets. Flanked by Scourge, the Targetmaster Slugslinger and one of the Sweeps.

Flying a close distance to them is Sixshot in the form of a flying winged puma...

... and the Combaticons Onslaught and Brawl flying in robot-mode.

PANEL 3:

WIDE SHOT, HIGH ANGLE - At the same time a large swarm of atmospheric fighters is rising up to confront them.

PANEL 4:

And on the surface meanwhile troops of tank-like combat-vehicles and gun turrets are being activated and ground troops mobilized.

The natives were a human-like organic species. Their technology however is only slightly more advanced than the humans had been when they had first met the transformers.

PANEL 5:

WIDE SHOT - The native air fighters approaching the Decepticons are firing dozens of missiles at the Decepticons.

PANEL 6:

But the Decepticons, with their more advanced weapons, just shoot the missiles and destroy them before they reach them.

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PANEL 1:

And in return the Decepticons open fire themselves.

Cyclonus missiles hit one of the native aircrafts and blows it to atoms.

PANEL 2:

The explosion damages another native fighter and forces two more to change course.

PANEL 3:

Scourge and two of his Sweeps blasts hit and blow up a second aircraft.

With Slugslinger destroying a third one next to them.

PANEL 4:

Sixshot (now in jet-mode), Apeface, Snapdragon, Vortex, Ramjet, Thrust, Misfire, Flywheels and Triggerhappy (who lives up to his name) shoot down a dozen more within seconds.

Which causes the rest of the native fighters to withdraw.

It was not so much a battle, but a one sided massacre.

TRIGGERHAPPY

Look, they are running.

CYCLONUS

No reason to get too excited. This creatures were never a worthy opponent for us in the first place.

PANEL 5:

WIDE SHOT, HIGH ANGLE - Meanwhile on the ground another Sweep and the Seekers Skywraith and Gunwing blow up a couple of tanks.

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PANEL 1:

WIDE SHOT, NORMAL ANGLE - Galvatron is blowing up a defense installation with two large gun-turrets on top of it, leaving just a large crater in the ground.

PANEL 2:

Then he re-aims his cannon and destroys two more tank vehicles.

Galvatron looks around at the destruction around him. The military base is reduced to burning wreckage and rubble.

He sees the bodies of a few dead soldiers lying in between, while others are fleeing in panic.

GALVATRON

This should be enough. I think they understand the situation.
Skorponok send our `offer` to surrender to the natives.

Just a few months ago, he knows, he would have probably lost himself in the fight and simply continued the destruction and carnage just for the sake of it.

But not anymore. He is not longer insane.

There is no reason to lay waste to the planet he intends to conquer.

PANEL 3:

EXT. A group of the Decepticons is standing in front of the building that they had identified as the government building - or at least the military control-center - of this place.

WIDE-SHOT - The Decepticons present are Galvatron, Cyclonus, Scourge and two Sweeps, Zarak in his Headmaster robot-suit, Slugslinger, Triggerhappy and Misfire, Astrotrain and Mindwipe and Weirwolf in their beast-modes with their nebulon partners standing next to them...

Devastator, Menasor and Bruticus...

... and in some greater distance the rest of the Decepticon force and Skorponok's city-mode just outside the borders of the natives city.

Captioned: It is a show of force.

PANEL 4:

WIDE SHOT - A number of the natives are standing outside of the building. They had been waiting for the Decepticons. All of them with a clear expression of fear.

With a large number of more citizens assembled around them in the city.

They are a humanoid species with light blue skin, looking not quite unlike humans or nebulons. Which was a bit surprising given that they were in another galaxy.

Only they had larger and lightly pointed ears (which made them look a bit like elves) and four fingers instead of five and seemingly completely black eyes. Their hair color ranged from shades of black to white. Their clothes seem to consist either of some kind of grey or white robes or more practical looking full-body suits.

Captioned: The name of the planet, as they had found out, was Alera.

PANEL 5:

WIDE SHOT - The leader of the alerians, by his appearance, is an old man.

He has completely white hair. Not that this seemed to say much about the age of his species, since many young have the same hair color. But his blue skin is also wrinkled and looks paler than the younger alerians.

Standing close to him are two middle aged dark haired men in a similar white robe like the Leader himself and a young female who had also white hair who is wearing a body-suit...

... and behind them a male and female who are wearing armor similar to the soldiers they had seen. Who are obviously guards.

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PANEL 1:

LOW ANGLE - The smaller Alerian Leader, visibly uneasy and desperate, LOOKING UP at Galvatron and Cyclonus.

ALERIAN LEADER

We did as you ordered. Please tell me are you machines serving the Kyrix?

CYCLONUS

(sharply)

We serve **nobody** but ourselves.

PANEL 2:

GALVATRON

Listen organic creatures, I am Galvatron - Leader of the Decepticons. You and your planet from now on belong to the Decepticon Empire.

From now on you only exist to further our goals and for the glory of the Decepticons.

ALERIAN LEADER

(confused)

You - you are letting us live?

Captioned: The tone in his voice suggested that this fact completely surprises him. Actually his voice sounded nearly... hopeful?

PANEL 3:

CLOSE SHOT at Galvatron's face.

GALVATRON

The dead are of no use to us. As little use as your frail organic species is anyway.

Captioned: Despite his indifferent words, he can not help to feel somehow surprised by the Leader's reaction.

PANEL 5:

CLOSE SHOT at the female alerian standing next to the Leader.

FEMALE ALERIAN

What if the Kyrix are coming for this planet, like they did for others?
Are you going to defend us from them?

PANEL 6:

Galvatron lifts his right arm with his particle-cannon in a aggressive gesture.

GALVATRON

I will **destroy** everyone else who is trying to claim this planet.

Captioned: The reaction to this words however is the last thing what Galvatron or any of the other Decepticons would have expected.

PAGE 10:

PANEL 1:

WIDE SHOT - The Leader lowers his head to them, just like the alerians next to him. Then the Leader says a word the Decepticons first think has been mistranslated.

ALERIAN LEADER

SAVIOR.

Captioned: The Leader is the first one who says it, closely followed by his entourage and...

PANEL 2:

WIDE SHOT – at the crowd of blue skinned humanoids chanting the same word.

ALERIAN CROWD

Savior, savior... savior.

SWEEP

What in the world is going on here?

Captioned: There had not been many situations in his life where Galvatron has been completely dumbfounded. But this is definitely one of them.

PANEL 3:

CAPTION: Inside Skorponok, a short time later.

CYCLONUS

By what we have found out from the alerians, the Kyrix are a race that has during the last 40 years conquered at least 3 habitated planets in this part of space...

PANEL 4:

CYCLONUS

(CONT.)

... and completely wiped out the native population. They also attacked several other planets, including THIS one.

PANEL 5:

CYCLONUS

(CONT.)

The kyrix are an organic species. Their technological level seems to be comparable to the human's current one.

Captioned: With other words, no REAL THREAT to them.

ZARAK

I am starting to see why they consider being conquered by **us** as some kind of salvation.

PANEL 6:

CLOSE SHOT at Galvatron with a smile forming on his face.

GALVATRON

No matter. It seems we have a competitor in this part of space. We will soon show them how it is to **be** conquered.

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PANEL 1:

CLOSE ON - at Galvatron.

GALVATRON (cont.)

Tell the alerians we are taking control of their planet's energy sources. The first priority is to get Skorponok repaired. Oh - and Zarak, I will tell the Constructicons to install a few security protocols.

PANEL 2:

SPLIT PANEL – of Galvatron and Zarak's faces.

GALVATRON (cont.)

Just in case you come to the idea to for example... use it against me.

ZARAK

Of course Galvatron.

PANEL 3:

CAPTION: Planet Cybertron, IACON SPACEPORT. Optimus, the Targetmasters, Spike, Daniel and Arcee have by now returned to Cybertron. Here they are already being expected. By more than one person.

WIDE SHOT – At the just landed shuttle, with Optimus, Spike, Daniel, Arcee and Kup stepping outside and Ultra Magnus and Carly waiting for them.

DANIEL

Mom!

PANEL 4:

CARLY

I have heard what happened, to Daniel... and to you.

SPIKE

There was no other choice. It was either this or our son would have been unable to even move.

Captioned: Daniel nearly killed. Both of them becoming Headmasters. Yes, a lot had happened.

PANEL 5:

CARLY

I know, Ultra Magnus has told me everything.

They both embrace each other.

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PANEL 1:

CAPTION: Cybertron, Vector Sigma

WIDE SHOT - Optimus Prime, Hotrod and Ultra Magnus have once again entered the underground-hall inside Cybertron of the super-computer Vector Sigma.

Optimus has the now emptied shell of the Matrix in his hand.

ULTRA MAGNUS

Are you sure about this?

OPTIMUS

I have to do this.

Captioned: ... and once again he uses it to activate Vector Sigma.

PANEL 2:

The transparent figure of Alpha Trion appears before them.

TWO SHOT: Alpha Trion and Optimus

ALPHA TRION (projection)

Optimus - why have you come again?

OPTIMUS

I had to talk to you. There are some questions I have.

PANEL 3:

ALPHA TRION

Questions?

OPTIMUS

About the things that happened. Galvatron is still out there. He and Zarak are now in an unknown part of space. They could attack other planets and we would not even know about it.

Captioned: Optimus Thinking: ... 'as a result of Vector Sigma's own plan.'

PANEL 4:

ALPHA TRION

Do not bother about Galvatron. He is not longer your problem to worry about.

OPTIMUS

But...

PANEL 5:

ALPHA TRION

Galvatron is fulfilling his own role in the plan. Leave now - and enjoy the New Golden Age that you and your Autobots had brought for Cybertron.

The projection of Alpha Trion shows a smile on his face as he said this to them.

Captioned: For a moment Optimus, Hotrod and Ultra Magnus want to believe him. But they can still not help but feel that something was wrong. And then...

PANEL 6:

Suddenly the figure of a second Alpha Trion appears right next to them, a few meters beside the first one.

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PANEL 1:

SECOND ALPHA TRION

No - you MUST NOT listen to him Optimus! He has been corrupted... the enemy.

PANEL 2:

CLOSE SHOT - The form of the second Alpha Trion suddenly starts to flicker before their eyes and he bends down slightly, nearly as if he is in pain.

SECOND ALPHA TRION

The Darkness - the Darkness is...

Captioned: They remember that the figure of Alpha Trion they see is only a projection. His true self, his spark, was merged with the super computer. So more than one of them appearing was possible. Feeling pain however should have not, just like the two disagreeing and accusing each other. What was going on here?

PANEL 3:

WIDE SHOT - Then he and the first one both disappear. There is nothing but empty spots were both had been a moment before.

PANEL 4:

CLOSE SHOT - Ultra Magnus with Optimus standing close to him.

ULTRA MAGNUS

I think this settles it. Vector Sigma must be malfunctioning somehow, maybe even gone insane. We should not longer activate it, at least for the time being.

OPTIMUS

I agree with you.

Captioned: And Alpha Trion mind – and his spark - was trapped inside of it. Optimus wished he knew a way to help his mentor. But he had none. At least not now.

PANEL 5:

HOTROD

But this means we have lost BOTH the Matrix **and** Vector Sigma.

OPTIMUS

We will restore the Matrix... over time. And we will try to correct whatever is wrong with Vector Sigma, somehow.

Captioned: They all **knew** how small the chances of that were. Vector Sigma was older than Cybertron itself. Nobody alive really fully understood it.

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PANEL 1:

CLOSE SHOT - Optimus looks downwards as the full implications of what they found out fully settle in. Vector Sigma was broken, somehow defect.

And he had blindly followed it's orders.

No, looking back it seemed as if Vector Sigma had used some kind of mental influence on him. He had been manipulated by it.

OPTIMUS

What have I done?

PANEL 2:

WIDE SHOT - The three leave the hall,

Captioned: For a moment both Optimus and Hotrod both feel as if they hear quiet deep laughter hailing through the room as they leave. But only for a short moment. As they turn around there is nothing there.

PANEL 3:

CAPTION: Autobot City Earth - 8 months later. December the 24rd 2007 - Christmas Eve

WIDE SHOT - It is Winter. The area around Autobot City is covered in snow.

PANEL 4:

INT. A conference room inside Autobot City

CAPTION: Ultra Magnus is in a... well - interesting meeting.

WIDE SHOT - He is currently in the company of three humans. They are sitting together at a specially modified table on different-sized chairs.

This humans are Carly, Marissa Fairborn... and a middle aged man who is wearing a strange looking grey robe with two vertical metallic silvery stripes along it's shoulders and two symbols painted on them, resembling the old-egyptian Aang and the Omega symbol.

ULTRA MAGNUS

(thinking)

Why is it always me who has to take care of things like this?

Captioned: His guests are EDC Captain and one of his personal friends - Marissa Fairborn, Carly, - who had taken over as Ambassador to Cybertron from her husband. While Spike had switched to being Ambassador to Nebulon instead.

The third however is a representative and so called CARDINAL of the so called 'Church of Cybertron'. A new, well - Religion, that had spread during the last years.

PANEL 5:

TWO SHOT – Ultra Magnus and the Church of Cybertron Cardinal

CARDINAL

Please Holy One - could you at least consider our request?

ULTRA MAGNUS

For the last time Cardinal, we will not hand you over the bodies of any dead Transformers. Neither Autobots or Decepticons.

And would you please stop calling me Holy One?

Captioned: There had actually been a trend going on in human society for a long time now that more and more humans came to use cybernetic and even completely robotic enhancements, not simply to repair injuries, but to become stronger and to enhance their lifespan.

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PAGE 1:

CLOSE SHOT on the 'Cardinal'.

CARDINAL

You should not think that we would disrespect the bodies. They would be objects of worship and we would only perform the research that is permitted and legal. We are an integrous and true faith.

Captioned: The 'Church of Cybertron' however has taken it one step further, to worshipping Transformers - Cybertronians - and making it their declared goal to become more similar to them and turn themselves into 'higher beings' as well.

Most other humans consider them a 'weird cult'. But that doesn't change that they have by now gained a larger number of followers and resources.

PANEL 2:

CLOSE SHOT on Marrisona.

MARISSA

Captioned: It was in fact this incident that caused Marrisona to first actually draw the attention of the Autobots to this particular sect.

PANEL 3:

CARDINAL

There are always some bad sheep in every Religion. Most of our members are good citizens who just want to use technology to become divine beings as well.

Or at least as CLOSE as possible

ULTRA MAGNUS

We are NOT divine beings.

PANEL 4:

CARDINAL

Holy One - you can live for millions of years, maybe even forever. You are physically much stronger than us. You can change shapes, repair injuries and even transfer yourself to other bodies. How can you DENY it?"

ULTRA MAGNUS

(thinking)

Yes - why was it always **him** who had to take care of things like this?
How am I even supposed to reply to something THIS crazy?

PANEL 5:

WIDE SHOT - It is in this moment that BLASTER and JAZZ come practically running through the door.

JAZZ

Ultra Magnus - we have just received an transmission.

ULTRA MAGNUS

And that is important enough to just burst in here?

Captioned: Secretly though Magnus is glad for this interruption.

PANEL 6:

BLASTER

In this case yes. A ship has just entered the system and is approaching Earth. They are Quintessons - Quintessons... and they are asking for ASYLUM and for our help.

JAZZ

It comes even worse. They claim that a group of Decepticons has taken over their new home system.

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PANEL 1:

WIDE SHOT - That statement is enough to make all of them stare in open surprise - Magnus, Carly, Marrison and even the 'Cardinal' from the Church of Cybertron.

PANEL 2:

CLOSE SHOT on Ultra Magnus face.

ULTRA MAGNUS

I see, this **is** serious. I am sorry Cardinal, but it seems we have to interrupt our meeting.

Captioned: Magnus barely manages to hide his smile.

PANEL 3:

CAPTION: A few kilometers away from Autobot City, at the closest neighboring human town

WIDE SHOT - The town and the surrounding area is covered in snow. It is the picture of a peaceful looking winter landscape.

Optimus is standing in the snow covered landscape. And he is looking at a few humans doing their daily business.

That included a group of children playing in the snow.

Captioned: Optimus, who is currently off-duty, has been taken a drive to relax and have some time for himself. Peace - Had they really achieved it this time? There had not been any fighting for more than a half year now. The remaining Decepticons had withdrawn and gone into hiding.

It seems some good has come out of all this after all.

PANEL 4:

In this moment Optimus sees Ultra Magnus and Hotrod approaching.

ULTRA MAGNUS

Optimus – our ‘guests’ are about to arrive.

Captioned: ‘Of course there was the possibility that Galvatron and Zarak were out there in unknown space conquering one planet after, while he and the other Autobots are sitting here and having a peaceful time,’ Optimus thinks sarcastically.

PANEL 5:

CAPTION: Autobot City

INT. The same conference room like before, a half hour later

WIDE SHOT - Optimus, Ultra Magnus, Hotrod, Jazz, Blaster, Carly and Marrison are sitting together together with two Quintesson Judges, a General with the typical look of one face and sharp metallic teeth and one Quintesson Scientist.

1st QUINTESSON JUDGE

As you know, we lost control of our new home system during the Hate Plaque epidemic.

The insane driven Sharkticons had forced us off our planets. That means the ones of us who had not been killed by them. And we have NOT been able to regain control."

PAGE 17:

PANEL 1:

ULTRA MAGNUS

(sarcasm)

So your slaves rebelled and kicked you off the world you controlled, like it happened on Cybertron. We **really** feel sorry for you here.

PANEL 2:

QUINTESSON GENERAL

We were not able to regain control, but someone **else** was. We managed to deactivated most of the Guards when they went insane.

In our absense they somehow managed to change their programming and reactivated them and then used them to take over the Sharkticons.

PANEL 3:

QUINTESSON JUDGE

One of our remaining spy-drones was able to get a picture of the being who now control our system.

He lifts a small holo-projector he was holding in his tentacles... and activates it.

PANEL 4:

CLOSE ON - on Optimus face.

OPTIMUS

That is impossible.

PANEL 5:

The picture shows nobody else than Cyclonus, with a Sweep standing next to him and worse, Galvatron's flagship the Revenge hanging in the sky behind them.

PANEL 6:

HOTROD

Cyclonus was inside Skorponok. We saw him. He nearly killed you.

Optimus next to him nods.

PAGE 18:

PANEL 1:

CAPTION : The Decepticon City Trypticon, somewhere in space.

EXT. Trypticon is in city-mode somewhere on the surface of an unpopulated planetoid.

PANEL 2:

INT. Inside Trypticon

WIDE SHOT – SOUNDWAVE, with RUMBLE, FRENZY and RAVAGE at his side, is standing before a large number of Decepticons.

Captioned: The temporary and provisorical Decepticon Leader Soundwave is looking at many of the remaining Decepticons that are gathered inside Trypticon.

PANEL 3:

First there is BLITZWING

Captioned: In opposite to his earlier words Galvatron had accepted Blitzwing back a short time after their falling out.

PANEL 4:

then the two Seekers DARKWING and DREADWIND and the Pretenders BOMBURST, SKULLGRIN, IQUANUS, BUGLY and SUBMARAUDE standing next to them.

... and a large number of others – Seekers, car-, tank and animal-mode Decepticons.

Captioned: It are nearly a hundred Decepticons assembled here alone. But most of the best and most powerful are gone. For security reasons their headquarter on Chaar was no longer save and they moved on this planetoid for now. To spare energy Trypticon also staid in city-mode and had most of his systems deactivated.

PANEL 5:

... including a number of Micromasters standing between the legs of their much larger peers, including members of the Air Strike, Sports Car and Military-Patrols.

And a large number of others.

Captioned: The question was: What now?

PAGE 19:

PANEL 1:

DARKWING

We could try to find another planet with rich energy resources and take it over.

SOUNDWAVE

The Autobots would be on us in no time in any known system.

We would have to leave known space entirely and find an unknown planet. Not to mention the energy it would cost us to **get** there.

PANEL 2:

CLOSE SHOT on Soundwave.

SOUNDWAVE

(CONT.)

A risk we might have to TAKE.

Captioned: It is at this time that they are receiving a message.

PANEL 3:

The face that appears on the screen before them belonged to nobody else than Cyclonus.

SOUNDWAVE

Impossible.

Captioned: Ironically his reaction perfectly mirror Optimus Prime's.

PANEL 4:

Standing beside Cyclonus on the screen is a Sweep... and the Insecticons Shrapnell and Venom.

CYCLONUS

Soundwave, Blitzwing - as you can see, despite claims of the opposite, I have NOT disappeared together with Galvatron.

PANEL 5:

CLOSE SHOT at Blitzwing's face.

Captioned: The Insecticons. Blitzwing for his part could have easily lived without ever seeing **them** again.

PANEL 6:

REVERSE ANGLE – Blitzwing looking at the screen with the picture of Cyclonus, the Sweep and Shrapnell.

Captioned: It was some years ago they had managed to clone fully sentient copies of themselves. Megatron had tolerated it, to some limit. In short he had threatened to eliminate the entire group should he find out that they created more than one set of sentient clones at ones.

PAGE 20:

PANEL 1:

SOUNDWAVE

Data confirmed Cyclonus was inside Skorponok... and yet you are here.

CYCLONUS

It seems your data is faulty. I have obviously not been on Skorponok. Otherwise I would also be on the other side of the universe right now. Isn't that right?

SOUNDWAVE

Correct.

PANEL 2:

CYCLONUS

Good that we agree. I am taking over until Galvatron returns. I want you to bring Trypticon to the former Quintesson Sector.

BLITZWING

Who tells us that this call is not a fake and that you are who you claim to be? This could be a trap.

PANEL 3:

CYCLONUS

Are you questioning my authority Blitzwing?

BLITZWING

No.

PANEL 4:

CYCLONUS

Good - you remember what happened the last time you questioned a Decepticon Leader. I expect you within 100 Astro-hours.

PANEL 5:

The screen becomes dark.

CLOSE SHOT - Soundwave and Blitzwing look at each other without saying a word.

PANEL 6:

CAPTION: Light-years away in the former Quintesson territory.

WIDE SHOT - 'Cyclonus' had just ended the transmission.

The two Insecticons beside him take a step closer to him.

(Sentient) SHRAPNELL

That was a great performance, BOMBSHELL – BOMBSHELL.

PAGE 21:

PANEL 1:

CAPTION: Autobot City Earth

INT. The Autobots and the two humans are now sitting together to discuss their conversation with the group of Quintessons.

ULTRA MAGNUS

Our Quintesson 'friends' are save and secure in a few cells in our brig.

MARISSA

I wish we could just leave them there, but they had officially requested asylum.

PANEL 2:

HOTROD

Another question is, how much of what they said is even true? That picture of Cyclonus and also this entire story might be fabricated.

OPTIMUS

We will have to observe the sector and find out the truth ourselves.

PANEL 3:

CAPTION: Millions of light-years away, the planet Alera. It has come like the alerians had expected it would. The species known as the Kyrix is making a 'visit' to their world.

WIDE SHOT - Three large battleships, each rivalling Skorponok in size, are approaching the planet. These three ships are releasing hundreds of smaller fighters and shuttles.

While Skorponok rises up from the surface into the orbit, along with dozens of Decepticons in aircraft or robot form and are engaging them

PANEL 4:

WIDE SHOT - Cyclonus in his jet-mode is flying in front of a group consisting of Scourge, two Sweeps and the other Targetmasters, who are destroying enemy fighters left and right.

Then Cyclonus fires a couple of his missiles, quickly followed by another two at one of the large battleships.

PANEL 5:

The Kyrix ships possess energy-shields, but their technology is not comparable to the Decepticon's or Autobot's.

So their shields instantly break down and Cyclonus remaining missiles pierce through the hull into the bridge and machine-section... and are blowing the ship up from the inside out, killing the entire crew.

Galvatron is standing on Skorponok's space ship form. He transforms into his cannon-mode and fired a shot with his full power at one of the other two enemy ships.

PANEL 6:

CAPTION: Cyclonus remembers how a similar shot had blown up the dwarf planet Thrull.

The same happens now to the second Kyrix battleship, as it blowing up in a gigantic explosion.

While the third one is being destroyed under the combined fire of Bruticus, Predaking, Abominus and Sixshot.

As the other Decepticons are decimating the remaining enemy fighters.

The battle is over within minutes.

Captioned: And at the same time, yet another war has begun.

This story is based on the original Transformers ReAnimated stories that I have discovered some time ago and of course of the original cartoon itself.

Like Transformers ReAnimated is the author's idea for the events between Season 2 and the Movie, this is mine for a continuation of the series after 'Rebirth'.

'Dark Victory – part 1' is the first part of a three-part story and serves so as pilot multiparter.

xxx

Regarding the 'two Cyclonus' reveal at the end.

The idea was actually inspired by the '10.000 pardons, you mean Bombshell...' short film written by Flint Dille and Co.

Which - aside from confirming Skywarp to be (the real) Cyclonus – suggested, mostly jokingly, that the second Cyclonus during the reformation scene in the movie might actually exist and just had deserted shortly after his creation.

Here however the idea is taken more serious and part of an important plot-line. The circumstances about how and why however are still secret for now and will be revealed in the next two issues.

The idea that the Insecticons had by the time of the Movie been able to create sentient clones is pretty much my explanation of their appearances after the Sweeps had been reformed.

Since the NON-sentient clones are shown to fall apart as soon as they are not longer controlled by the originaly, logically at least one set of clones that can at least exist independent at the point of the movie.

This scrip was as I admit to some degree also inspired by some of my personal issues about the Rebirth three-parter.

Like Vector Sigma's 'plan' endangering multiple populated worlds and Optimus Prime just getting along with it without question and even considering the idea of destroying the Key to the Plasma Energy Chamber.

Or Galvatron trying to destroy Cybertron AFTER the Decepticons had already successfully reconquered it. And even more important, no other Decepticon even disagreed with that plan.

With Galvatron alone, you could have argued that he was still (or was once again) insane. But since the other Decepticons just accepted the idea without saying a single word, this is obviously a writing issue and not one of Galvatron's mental state.

That Galvatron, Cyclonus and Scourge – just as Optimus as well – had been under some kind of mental influence by Vector Sigma/the Matrix to engage his plan to restore Cybertron is an idea that had made more and more sense to me, the more I thought about it.

At the same time however the idea came to me – what if Vector Sigma had somehow been corrupted and could no longer be trusted? And Optimus that blind obedience to it had not been such a good idea after all?

Which leads me to another point that bothered me about that entire Rebirth storyline.

At the end of Rebirth Galvatron and the Decepticons are sent to an unknown area of space and are given pretty much free reign to attack and conquer as many planets there as they want to, as a result of Vector Sigma's plan.

And neither Vector Sigma or Optimus seemed to be bothered by that at all?

Well, to some degree this thought ultimately led me to some of the ground ideas for this storyline. I however fully intend Dark Victory to be a story in its own right, instead of just a 'fix-it' for Rebirth.

There is also to a smaller degree the fact that many (Decepticon) characters simply do not appear in Rebirth, who should have been on the forefront (Trypticon, Sweeps, unnamed Decepticons etc.), despite that it were supposedly all Decepticons involved in the battle.

My explanation is that they were there, but simply never shown on screen.

First of, I find the idea utterly stupid that the entire Decepticon and Autobot forces would consist only of the named characters at the point of season 3/4. Which would make both the Decepticon army (who have the stated goal to conquer the universe) and the Autobots (who have the stated goal to stop them) be less than 100 people each. And this would make the entire Autobot-Decepticon war a complete joke.

Besides, both The Movie and Five Faces of Darkness suggests that the Decepticon forces are far larger and include a great number of unnamed Decepticons.

The Movie showed a few glimpses of this greater army when Unicron attacked.

Five Faces of Darkness – animation errors aside – had the Decepticon forces attacking Cybertron be shipped in by five Quintesson ships.

One of these ships is shown to be able to carry at least 40 to 50 Decepticons. Which suggests that Galvatron's invasion-force consisted of at least 200 to 250 Decepticons. And that with many Decepticons not even part of that invasion-force.

For this story, most of the known Decepticons (and several more) were inside Skorponok when it was hit by the plasma-energy-blast and most who were not were with Soundwave and Trypticon, who had lifted off from Cybertron's surface earlier, before Galvatron opened the chamber.

Also, when Optimus said 'all Decepticons' there is also the possibility that he just meant Galvatron's army, but not necessary all members of the Decepticon race.
